The Feeling 39 DI is a well laid out and therefore a very spacious sailing yacht. With the variable draft, the Feeling 39 DI has an enormous sailing area and can dry out with the double rudders.

#### **Accommodation:**

Saloons: Deck salon, Foredeck, port-starboard cabin, toilet/shower room, kitchen and navigation room, salon

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## Just some more information about the work done on our boat 'SPECIAL FEELING'.

As previously mentioned, and passed on, a lot has been done to the boat in recent years in terms of maintenance/repair and replacement.

- After purchasing our boat in 1996, the sails were renewed in 1998. A new (black) spray hood (with INOX brackets, etc.) was also 'custom made' and installed. A new boiler was also installed (only works on the engine). Over the years, every 2 years, the sails have been taken to the (Dutch) sail maker for a check-up. About 10 years ago a 'Gennaker' was purchased (unfortunately little used).
- The Perspex windows were renewed about 14 years ago and in the winter of 2021-22 (with the renewal of the inner cladding) all bolts of the windows were renewed.
- A yellow Bimini was made in 2010 and a black Bimini in 2011 (only this one is used). This was completely checked/stitched by the (Dutch) sailmaker in early 2024.
- In 2015, the mast and stays were checked (by an official rigger) and found to be in order.
- In 2016 new Raymarine 6000 ST autopilot installed and completely checked in 2020
- In 2017 Replaced the gas hose (from stove to gas tank) with a stainless-steel flexible gas hose
- In 2018 a new 'winter tent' was made that covers the boat from mast to pushchair/swimming platform.
- Every year the engine has been checked by an official mechanic and made ready for sailing. The gearbox was overhauled last summer (2023) and this spring (2024) new engine mounts have been/will be installed under the engine and the entire engine will also be checked and renewed/repaired where necessary.
- In 2018 a solar panel was installed, and all batteries were replaced in 2019.
- In 2019 a new INOX anchor chain of 100m.
- In 2020 all lights were replaced with LED lamps.
- In summer 2021, a new forestay was installed (by sailmaker/rigger WAYPOINT in Lefkas) together with a new Profurl furling jib installation. The entire rigging was checked and found to be in good order (according to the rigger, 'it's a shame to buy new'). The attachment of the cutter stay has been reinforced below decks. The double guardrail wires were also replaced and damage to the 'nose' was repaired (polyester work). Also 2 new DELTA anchors.

- In winter 2021-22, the underwater hull was completely sandblasted and provided with new epoxy layers and antifouling, with the metal plate around the centerboard being replaced by an INOX plate. The mast of the boat was also inspected, and the deck/steam light was replaced as well as the wiring.
- In winter 2021-22, the entire interior lining was renewed (walls and ceilings of all cabins, salon and toilet area, etc.). The water drains and hoses of the wastewater tank/toilet, etc. were also renewed. Blackout and anti-mosquito shutters have been installed on all hatches.
- In spring 2022, replaced the bow thruster propeller for a 6-blade propeller (works a lot better).
- In spring 2023, the bearings of both rudder blades and the steering gear were renewed.
- In spring 2023, the outboard motor was completely checked and made ready for sailing.
- In summer 2023, the rigging was checked again (by official rigger 'Waypoint') and adjusted to the correct tension. Rigging, although old, found to be in good condition (accepted by insurance).
- In summer 2023, Gearbox overhauled, new VOLVO seal on the propeller shaft, engine seawater cooling unit overhauled.
- In spring 2024, New engine supports (vibration dampers), Entire engine checked and repaired/renewed where necessary,
- In spring 2024, New antifouling.

## Work still to be done on the 'Special Feeling'

As mentioned, (on the long list), many repairs have been made to the boat in recent years to keep her 'up to date'. However, it is and remains a 'used' boat and therefore naturally has some signs of wear.

There are also still some minor repairs/renewals to be done.

- Webasto heating not working (incomplete)
- Main VHF does not work due to incorrect electrical connection.
- · Radio/cd player must be checked
- Mast top light does not work, and steam/deck light is connected incorrectly (electricity).
- · Lamps in the ceiling of the salon not connected.
- 1 lamp in port cabin is not working (connected).
- New layer of varnish on top of the navigation table.
